



FIDIC 2017. V COCOA International Independent Dance Festival.

FIDIC is a two yearly independent and international festival that brings together local, regional and foreign artists in a dance event that seeks to promote artistic production and creation, research, exchange and support among colleagues, as well as to facilitate training opportunities for the public through reflection and open debates for the community to participate. The Festival will take place from **8 to 23 September 2017** in the City of Buenos Aires, and its program will feature both national and international performances, urban interventions, research and exchange sessions, and joint production meetings between artists from different regions so as to foster cross-cultural exchange.

FIDIC's program has many different sections: international, regional and local performances that will take place at conventional and unconventional locations, shows, spaces to reflect, meetings with artist-creators, videodance, projections and seminars. In this edition, there will be a place for dance to be expressed from a new perspective, including artists that address movement from a different viewpoint, and a multidisciplinary team is expected to provide its thorough analysis.

International Call for Entries

Our official call for entries opens on Wednesday, 29 June and closes on Sunday, 30 July 2016.

We call for international groups or companies. Those interested must complete and send the form to fidic2017@gmail.com

IMPORTANT: The link provided must contain a video (Vimeo, YouTube) showing a complete performance or a rehearsal (in case it's a premiere) in good image quality, filmed with a static and long shot, and without cuts. Any recording that does not comply with these conditions for its appropriate analysis could be rejected.

Attachments:

- Pictures. Two high-resolution representative pictures of the performance must be attached to the PDF form in PNG or JPEG format.
- Lightning diagram. The lightning diagram must be attached in JPEG format.
- Stage diagram: If available, the stage diagram must be attached in JPEG format.

The Festival offers the selected groups or companies:

- Accommodation and food for three days. By group we consider a maximum of 5 performers + 1 director + 1 technical operator, without exception. If the selected groups exceed this limit, expenses shall be the company's responsibility.
- Travel expenses in the City of Buenos Aires during the stay scheduled by the Festival.
- A sum of 500 to 1000 US dollars per group or company.
- Once a group has been selected, invitation letters will be sent, if requested, to allow companies to arrange their trips in their home countries, given that the Festival does not cover international air or ground travel expenses.
